

>>Post-op Care Instructions

for patient:

Bone Augmentation

> Bone grafting material has been placed in one or more places in your jaw bone.

> A resorbable membrane may also have been placed over the bone graft. This membrane will aid in the prevention of tissue growing into the bone graft so that your natural bone will have a head start fusing in and around the bone graft.

> Sutures have been placed over the bone graft site to hold the material and blood clot in place.

> Slight bleeding may occur for the first 24 hours. If it continues, please call our office as soon as possible.

> Antibiotics and pain medications may be prescribed, take them as directed. If you experience any

reactions to the medications, stop taking them and call our office as soon as possible.

> You may experience some aching for 3 to 5 days, that is the healing process taking effect.
